Objectives:

To review factors that determine physician adherence to practice guidelines, while optimizing healthcare delivery. Based on faculty experience with published gastrointestinal bleeding guidelines, the participants will explore how efficient collaborative guideline development can optimize adherence to clinical practice guidelines.

Key points:

Participants will develop a better understanding of current facilitators and barriers to physician adherence to clinical practice guidelines. This session will also inform participants on a current initiative aimed at enhancing the implementation of published clinical practice guidelines in gastrointestinal bleeding.

By participating in this workshop, participants will challenge and expand the traditional paradigm of developing and disseminating clinical guidelines. Participants will help create a new approach that integrates the scientific evidence into practice situated in multidisciplinary settings.
