Objectives:

EPIDD's primary aim is to improve the performance of three multidisciplinary (Physicians, Nurses) PCTs in providing care to T2D patients. Its secondary aim is to demonstrate the feasibility of the PI process used.

Key Points:

PI puts its emphasis on the assessment of measurable improvements in knowledge, skills, attitudes and professional practices, with measurable impact on the quality of patient care. However, like any other educational model, PI has its challenges and pitfalls that must be avoided. Through facilitated discussion, participants came up with solutions to overcome the expressed challenges, and an example of best practices was shared.
